MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison (USAG) Baden-Wuerttemberg Command Policy Memorandum # 68, Use of Vehicle Resale Lot for Sale of Privately-Owned Vehicles (POVs)

1. References:

- a. AR 215-1, Non-Appropriated Fund Instrumentality (NAFI) Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (FMWR) Activities.
- b. AE 190-1, Driver and Vehicles Requirements and the Installation Traffic Code for the U.S. Forces in Germany.
- c. AE 600-700, Identification Cards and Individual Logistical Support.
- d. USAG-BW Command Policy Letter #66, Abandoned Vehicles.

2. Purpose: To establish guidelines and procedures for the operation of the POV Resale Lot, a central location at which personnel may sell or purchase USAREUR-plated POVs. USAREUR-plated vehicles include cars, motorcycles, boats and recreational vehicles.

3. Scope: This policy applies to members of the U.S. Forces (Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force and Coast Guard) and the civilian component (including Family members) who are assigned to or employed within the geographic boundaries of Germany, and who are authorized a U.S. Forces Certificate of License and POV registration privileges under AE 600-700.

4. Procedures: The POV Resale Lot is the only authorized location on post to park a POV in order to display it for resale. Vehicles parked elsewhere in the United States Army Garrison Baden-Württemberg (USAG BW) community for the purpose of advertising their sale will be cited with an Armed Forces Traffic Citation (DD Form 1408). The USAG BW POV Resale Lot is located on Patrick Henry Village across from the Dental Clinic and the Military Police Station in Building 4511. Dealers and other persons who operate a car sales business will not be authorized use of this lot.

5. Policy: Vehicle owners desiring to park a vehicle in the POV Resale Lot may do so as long they meet the below criteria:

- a. Vehicle owners must first go to the Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (FMWR) Information, Tickets & Reservations (ITR) Office, located in the Village Pavilion Community

Center (VPCC), building 4507, to obtain a POV Resale Lot Parking Permit. Vehicles that do not have a POV Resale Lot Parking Permit will be reported to the USAG BW Military Police and impounded at the owner's expense. Before a permit is issued, the ITR Office will verify that the vehicle is operational and that the vehicle owner has a valid USAREUR vehicle registration. The USAREUR vehicle registration must be valid for more than 30 days. POV Resale Lot Parking Permits will be issued for 30 days. A onetime extension can be granted for an additional 30 days if the USAREUR vehicle registration remains valid. Due to the limited parking spaces on the POV Resale Lot, extensions will be granted on a case-by-case basis. Total vehicle time in the POV Resale Lot will not exceed 60 days. Only one vehicle per owner will be allowed on the POV Resale Lot at one time within a 60 day period. Exceptions must be approved by the FMWR Director.

b. Vehicles must remain legally parked and in full operational status while parked on the POV Resale Lot. Owners with vehicles that have excessive leaks of fluids (anti-freeze, oils, brake fluids, etc.) will not be allowed to park in the POV Resale Lot until all deficiencies are corrected. Any vehicle showing leakage must be removed immediately. Owners of vehicles with such leaks will be notified and the vehicle must be removed within 24 hours. If the vehicle is not moved within 24 hours it will be cited for environmental hazard and moved to the USAG-BW Impound Lot on Spinelli Barracks at the owner's expense. Vehicle repairs and/or maintenance are not permitted in the POV Resale Lot.

c. Vehicles will not be allowed to remain on the POV Resale Lot past the expiration date on the POV Resale Lot Parking Permit. Vehicle owners planning to be deployed, on temporary duty (TDY) or on extended leave, must move their vehicle from the POV Resale Lot. If the parking permit has expired, the ITR Office staff will attempt to contact the owner/POC and make arrangements to have them remove the vehicle. If the vehicle is not moved within 24 hours, the ITR Office staff will notify Military Police who will tag the vehicle for abandonment and relocate it to the USAG BW Impound Lot in accordance with USAG BW Command Policy Letter #66 at the owner's expense.
