





Heidelberg High School JROTC 2nd Battalion Supports The Landstuhl Regional Medical Center Wounded Warrior Ministry Chaplain's Clothes Closet



- This program was established in 2002 in response to combat casualties arriving to LRMC from Operation Enduring Freedom in Iraq and Afghanistan straight from the battlefield or dressed in operating room gowns. Wounded soldiers needed clothes, shoes, and toiletries as they recovered or awaited transportation to stateside medical centers or facilities closer to their families.
- During the November to January time frame, the Chaplain's Clothes Closet receives over one-and-a-half tons of mail and donations per week. The items are stored, sorted, and distributed to the hospital currently from three bunkers located approximately fifteen minutes from LRMC.
- On November 4, 2011, HHS JROTC cadets participated in a service learning project at the bunkers to show their appreciation and respect for the sacrifices of our military members.
- More support is needed. Community members are encouraged to volunteer at the Chaplain's Clothes Closet and support the selfless service of our wounded troops.
