Purpose

- To inform commanders that :
 - *Crime Prevention is a command responsibility*
 - *A successful program needs continuing command emphasis via a proactive assigned Crime Prevention officer program.*
 - *An effective Crime Prevention Program will help maximize the security of a military community.*

Unit level Crime Prevention Officers

- *Serve as their units focal points for Crime Prevention program implementation (where the rubber meets the Road!).*
- *Conducts unit level Crime Prevention trainings & briefings.*
- *Disseminates information to unit given from the Garrison CPO's and Supporting Agency.*

Garrison Crime Prevention Officer (CPO)

- *The Garrison CPO (DES Physical Security) will utilize the "Train the Trainer Concept" in order to instruct tenant unit level crime Prevention officers (72 hour course w/PE's).*
- *Develops and maintains the written crime prevention SOP.*
- *Inspects the implementation of unit level programs.*
